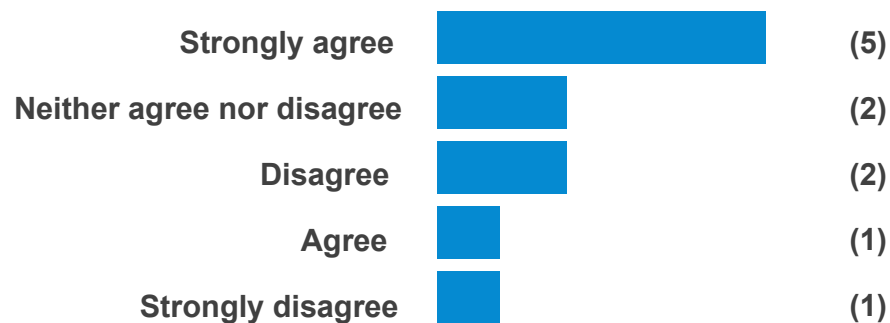

4	Everything is very descriptive and accurate and also protects everyone which is good	Supportive - no revision required

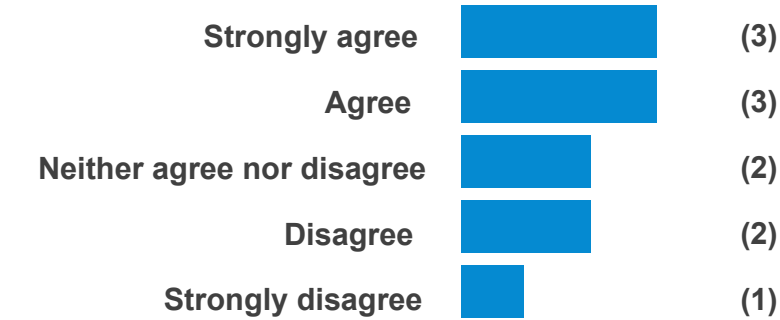

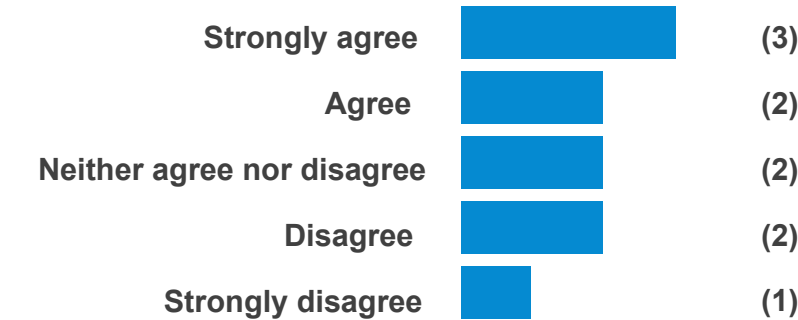
The Statement of Principles... (is positive)



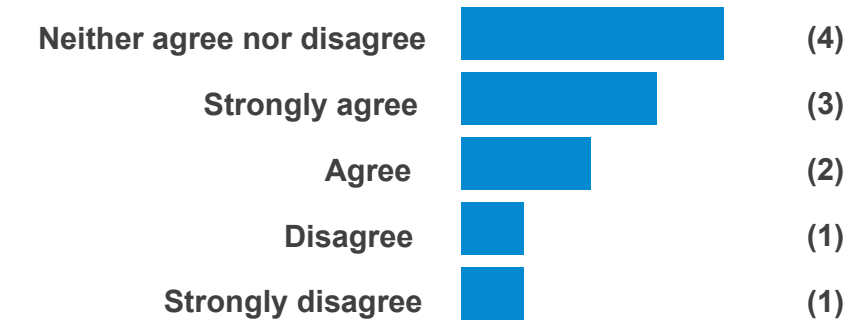
The Statement of Principles... (is easy to read)



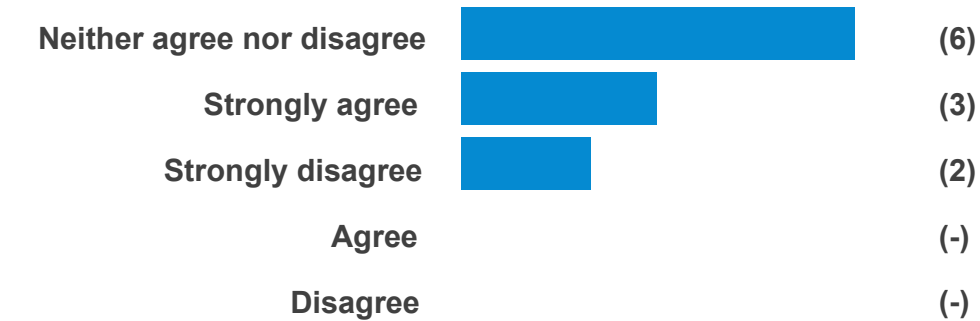
The Statement of Principles... (is easy to understand)



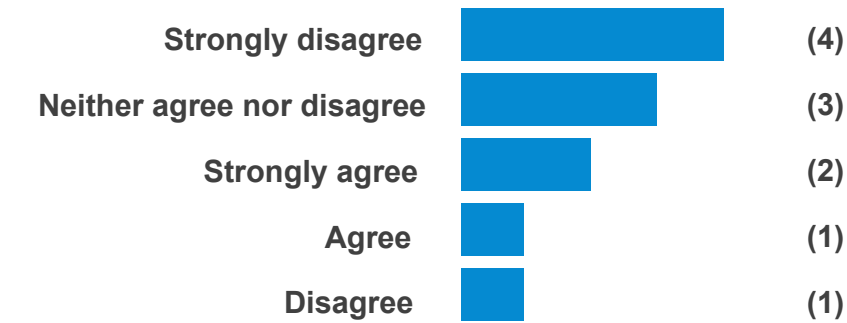
The Statement of Principles... (will help protect local residents)
