Urgent Key Decision

19/08 Gayton Swimming Pool

The Cabinet Member considered a report which stated the Court judgement required the Council to carry out such works as to put and keep the Gayton Pool and changing rooms in good repair and to reach agreement with the Community Association by 18 October 2008 to avoid the possibility of the Court appointing an 'expert' to determine the works necessary. Further detailed work on possible options had now been carried out and the best option was to replace the whole of the building and changing rooms with a new building detached from the Community Centre. The estimated cost of this proposal was in the region of £1 million. Revenue costs were being developed.

Suspension of call-in had been requested on this item but had been refused by the Chair of the Scrutiny Management Commission.
