Summary – £330k of money was secured as part of a section 106 agreement for part of the Heatherton development to be spent on improving leisure facilities within a mile radius of that phase of the estate. Originally intended to be used to help implement a City park on adjacent land, alternative schemes are now being considered in light of the City park proposal no longer being a realistic option.
