

Review of the response to Anti Social Behaviour complaints – Community Trigger

SUMMARY

- 1.1 This seeks Cabinet Member approval for implementation of an administrative process to deal with complaints of anti-social behaviour received from the public using the Antisocial Behaviour, Crime and Police Act 2014 - commonly referred to as a 'Community Trigger'.

RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 To note the report and approve implementation of the process arising from a 'Community Trigger' as detailed in Appendix 2

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 The council, along with the Police and Clinical Commissioning Groups, are defined by the Act as 'Relevant Bodies' with a statutory duty to have a 'Community Trigger' procedure and to advertise it widely to the public.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 4.1 The 2014 Act includes new measures, designed to give victims and communities a say in the way that anti-social behaviour is dealt with. The 'Community Trigger' gives victims the ability to demand action, starting with a review of their case, where the locally defined threshold is met.
