Minutes of previous minutes were confirmed.

**5/10 Neighbourhood Board Community Budget Proposals
2010/11**

The following was agreed:

Funding a 3G Dome Camera-£5,000.00. This is split between two budgets, £3,844.57 from the 6K Community Budget money and £1,155.43 from the 10K Community Safety, Highways & Youth provision money.

Funding to STOP (Spondon To Oppose Pollution)- £273.43. They requested £1,000.00 but the Board agreed to make a contribution of £273.43 representing what was left in the Community Budget. This is from the 6K Community Budget money. It was agreed that STOP, be encouraged to submit another application in the new financial year for the balance of the £1000.00 they had bid for.

Funding to Youth Services-£490.00. This is from the 10K Community Safety, Highways & Youth provision money.

Funding to Allestree Close Jitty footpath. Following on from the Ward Committee Minutes dated 20.09.10 costs

have now been received. Total funding approved is £4,500.00. This is split between two budgets, £2,000.00 from the 10K Community Safety, Highways & Youth provision money and £2,500.00 from the 10K Highways funding.

Funding to a new Bus Shelter near Yews Residential Home. Following on from the Ward Committee Minutes dated 20.09.10 costs have now been received. Total funding is £4,000.00. This is from the 10K Highways funding.

Funding five bollards on the corner of Beech Avenue. Following on from the ward Committee Minutes dated 20.09.10 costs have now been received. Total funding is £1,000.00. This is from the 10K Highways funding.

Also the Board approved the Steetpride 20K funding for 2011/12. The following was approved:

Meadow Lane, landscape and bollard plus maintenance for two years-£7,750.00.

Benches, Alvaston Park Friends have requested two park benches-£2,000.00.

Bin, outside newsagents near 645 London Road-£426.00.

Radar padlock, for gate at Green Lane-£30.00.

Coleman Street, ten new trees on grass verges along the Street. Consultation will have to take place with residents and check for services on grass verges-£1,260.00.

Grit Bins, two locations agreed were Elvaston Lane, speak with Michael Gray Board Member and Southgate Youth Centre, speak with Claire Sanderson, Centre Manager-£320.00.

Beech Avenue, carriageway widening to allow vehicles to pass parked cars. Costs will be between £6,000.00-£8,000.00.

Lincoln Avenue, cul de sac sign-Price to be confirmed.

Raynesway Garage Site, no entry sign if feasible. Liaise with resident at 3 Yew Tree Close-Price to be confirmed. Skips, if money left over locations will be confirmed-Price to be confirmed.
