# **Local Government Association Model Councillor Code of Conduct**

# **Purpose**

- 1.1 In June 2020 the Local Government Association (LGA) conducted a consultation to gather views on its draft Model Member Code of Conduct. A response was submitted on behalf of Derby City Council.
- 1.2 The LGA published its Model Councillor Code of Conduct in December 2020.
- 1.3 The Monitoring Officer and Democratic Services undertook an exercise to compare the Council's Councillors' Code of Conduct with the one published by the LGA. The results of this exercise and any suggested actions are attached at Appendix 1, for the Committee's consideration.

#### Recommendations

- 2.1 To consider the Council's Councillors' Code of Conduct against the LGA Model Councillor Code of Conduct and note the suggested actions detailed in Appendix 1.
- 2.2 To delegate authority to the Monitoring Officer, in consultation with the Chair of the Standards Committee, to prepare amendments to the Councillors' Code of Conduct for Council approval that reflect the suggested actions detailed in Appendix 1.

#### Reasons

- 3.1 To give the Standards Committee the opportunity to consider the Council's Councillor Code of Conduct against the LGA Model Councillor Code of Conduct.
- 3.2 To provide the Standards Committee with the opportunity to recommend any changes to the Councillors' Code of Conduct and to the Councillor Complaints Procedure.
