3/08	<p>Issues raised at the Forums</p> <p>New Zealand Forum</p> <p>Cobden Street fence – orders have been placed for the work to be carried out.</p> <p>Brigmore Walk gates – Ongoing</p> <p>Pruning of trees on Uttoxeter Old Road – The tree surgeon has looked at the trees and they do not need pruning according to the criteria.</p> <p>Bins being left on the street – All residents on Stanley St have been sent letters. Letters will also be sent to residents on Radbourne St and Langley Street. The matter is on the tasking meeting agenda. Pete will speak to Zoe Nettleship re issuing fixed penalty notices to residents who continue to leave their bins out.</p>	<p>Neighbourhood Team to send letters to Langley and Radbourne Street. 	<p>The Board was in agreement that Councillor Gerrard should write to Peter Price asking if ARRIVA buses could have a drop off and pick up point at Osnabruck Square and Northcliffe House.</p> <p>Mackworth Forum</p> <p>Arriva buses going too fast on the wider roads on Mackworth Estate – Highways will be carrying out speed checks.</p> <p>Lack of health centre on Mackworth Estate – A letter was sent to the Primary Care Trust. There are 2 branch surgeries on the estate.</p> <p>Traffic leaving A52 travelling too fast around blind bend, Radbourne Lane – Highways will look to erect an exit sign on the other side of the road.</p> <p>Cars driving too quickly along Prince Charles Ave – waiting for the survey equipment to become available. Inspector Keene stated that as far as he is aware the Force policy is to carry out speed checks in designated areas only. These are identified by the number of accidents that take place in the area.</p> <p>Poor lighting to public footpaths on the Mackworth Estate. Emma raised the matter at the PFI lighting meeting.</p> <p>There is a light on Finchley Ave that is not working. Pete will inform Street lighting.</p> <p>Councillor Higginbottom suggested Board members be issued with the telephone number for street lighting. Pete will arrange for a list of useful numbers to be distributed at the next forum meetings or on a newsletter to the Ward.</p> <p>To fit iron gates to the front doors of Streatham Rd Community Centre common room to prevent vandalism.
