- 7. We need to be sure that your proposal will help meet our Corporate and Neighbourhood priorities being also sustainable and deliverable. Please send in evidence of past performance/business plan or anything else relevant that will help us reach a judgement

We shall be grateful if you would kindly respond by providing your replies by no later than 6 November 2008. We attach a brief guide to help you and this indicates the relative value of the criteria we shall consider in our next assessment.
