Report of the Director of Education

### **SUMMARY OF REPORT**

- 1        Eight grant applications have been received from voluntary Playscheme and Special Needs Playscheme organisations.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

- 2.1     To agree the recommendation to provide grant aid to:

- Derby West Indian Community Association
- Derwent Community Playscheme
- Peartree Playscheme
- Jigsaw Playscheme
- Leapfrog Summer Playscheme
- Lord Street Community Nursery
- Wilmorton Holiday Activities
- Boulton St Mary's Church (New 2002)

subject to the terms detailed at paragraph 2.2 being met.

- 2.2     The conditions of grant are that the playscheme organisers will:

- supply the Council with their Ofsted registration number prior to the commencement of the playscheme
- supply the Council with a copy of any Ofsted reports on their schemes
- notify the Early Years Development and Childcare Team (EYDCT) of the playschemes.

- 2.3     Applicants will also be encouraged to work with the EYDCT.

### **REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION**

- 3        The organisations applying for grant aid meet the Council's criteria and objectives for these grant funding schemes.
