04/21 Waste Collection Replacement Container Policy

The Cabinet Member considered a report which stated the Council provided a kerbside waste collection service to all residents of Derby City. Collection containers vary in colour to enable residents to identify which container was used for each waste stream.

There was a lack of consistency across the containers, with only any additional garden waste recycling containers being charged at £40. This presented a potential barrier to recycling.

The Council was developing its waste strategy in line with the government's anticipated Waste and Resources Strategy for England with the aim of promoting recycling as the preferred method of waste disposal.

The decision to implement the refreshed waste container policy was made by Council Cabinet at its meeting on 16 December 2020 as part of the savings detailed in the MTFP 2021-22 – 2023-24 report. The purpose of this report was to recommend and seek a decision on the fees and charges for waste containers.

Resolved to approve the refreshed Waste Collection Container Policy which sought to encourage recycling by removing the £40 charge for additional garden waste recycling containers (brown bins) and set out new charges as follows:

Container type	Waste type	charge
Black	Residual waste	£25.00
Blue	Dry recyclable waste	Free of charge
Brown	Compostable waste	Free of charge
