34/09 Notes of the last meeting held on 24 November 2009

35/09 Updates on matters arising from the previous meeting

The Forum considered updates on matter arising from the previous meeting. The Forum were provided with an update on grants to voluntary organisations.

36/09 Work Programme 2009/2010

The Forum received a presentation on the Derby Core Strategy from Dave Brown. The Forum were given details of the core strategy and how it would set out what type of new development was needed in the City and where this would go. It was reported that the options paper would be provided to Forum members which would include topics such as housing growth, new shopping floorspace, amount of employment land, making buildings more sustainable and addressing transport issues. Members of the Forum were invited to drop in sessions at the Guildhall and could access documents on the Council's website or in Council buildings to provide their views before the consultation ended on 31 March 2010.
