

Urgent items due to be considered by Council Cabinet

Every month, the Council publishes a Forward Plan to indicate the key decisions that the Council Cabinet is likely to take in the months ahead.

The following decision need to be taken urgently in order that they can be implemented as quickly as possible. For this reason Council Cabinet is likely to consider it at a meeting on 13 July 2022. It was not included on the Forward Plan.

The item is detailed below

Item	Reason for non-inclusion on the Forward Plan
Derby Holiday Activity and Food Programme	This item was originally in the Forward Plan but was withdrawn as it was not thought to be a key decision. It was subsequently deemed to be a key decision and needs to be considered at the July 2022 meeting of Council Cabinet to allow the programme to run over the school summer holidays. The 2022 Holiday Activity and Food Programme in Derby will build on the success of previous years and follow the same mixed delivery model undertaken in 2021. This will involve Community Action Derby focussing on third sector provision across the city, and the Council delivering through schools and children’s centres. This will ensure all areas of the city can be reached in a coordinated and targeted way.
Late Item – Darley Mills Bridge – Delivery of a temporary footbridge and delivery options	This item is being brought to Council Cabinet in response to an urgent need to deliver a short term temporary bridge at Darley Mills. The option being considered was not available at the point when the Forward Plan was published and was therefore not included. Approving this item now, rather than waiting until the item could be included in the Forward Plan, allows for the temporary bridge to be put in place quickly to support both the community and local businesses.
