120/09 Call-in of Key Decision – Kedleston Road Integrated Transport Scheme

The Council Cabinet considered a report on Call-in of Key Decision – Kedleston Road Integrated Transport Scheme. On 27 October 2009 Council Cabinet took Key Decision 99/09 on the Kedleston Road Integrated Transport Scheme, which included implementing two stretches of bus lane in the Darley ward part of the Kedleston Road. On 2 November 2009 the decision was called in by the three Allestree ward councillors. A special meeting of the Planning and Transportation Commission was held on 10 November 2009 with the outcome that the call in was upheld and the Commission resolved to refer the matter back to Council Cabinet and recommended that

1. Council Cabinet delay a decision on proceeding with the proposals until the impact of Connecting Derby can be evaluated following that scheme's completion
2. The delay be used to afford to Allestree Councillors and Neighbourhood Board the same level of consultation and opportunity to comment that has been provided to Darley Councillors and Neighbourhood Board.

Decision

To reaffirm the previous decision to approve the traffic regulation orders as advertised so that bus, cycle and taxi lanes can be introduced as part of the 2009/10 programme and inform the objectors and bus operators of the decision.
