BYELAWS FOR PLEASURE GROUNDS, PUBLIC WALKS AND OPEN SPACES

Byelaws made under section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875 by the Council of Derby City Council with respect to the Arboretum, Normanton, Derby.

PART 1

GENERAL

General Interpretation

1. In these byelaws:

“the Council” means Derby City Council;

“the ground” means the area of the Arboretum which is delineated by black hatching on the plan attached to these Byelaws.

Application

2. These byelaws apply to the ground referred to in these Byelaws.

Opening times

3. No person shall enter or remain in the ground except during opening hours.

“Opening hours” means the days and times during which the ground is open to the public indicated by a notice placed in a conspicuous position at the entrance to the ground.

PART 2

MISCELLANEOUS

Obstruction

4. No person shall—

- (a) obstruct any officer of the Council in the proper execution of his duties;
- (b) obstruct any person carrying out an act which is necessarily to the proper execution of any contract with the Council; or
- (c) obstruct any other person in the proper use of the ground.

Savings

5. It shall not be an offence under these byelaws for an officer of the Council or any person acting in accordance with a contract with the Council to do anything necessary to the proper execution of his duty.
6. Nothing done in or under these byelaws shall in any respect prejudice or injuriously affect any public right of way through the ground, or the rights of any person acting lawfully by virtue of some estate, right or interest in, over or affecting the ground or any part of the ground.

Removal of offenders

7. Any person offending against any of these byelaws may be removed from the ground by an officer of the Council or a constable.

Penalty

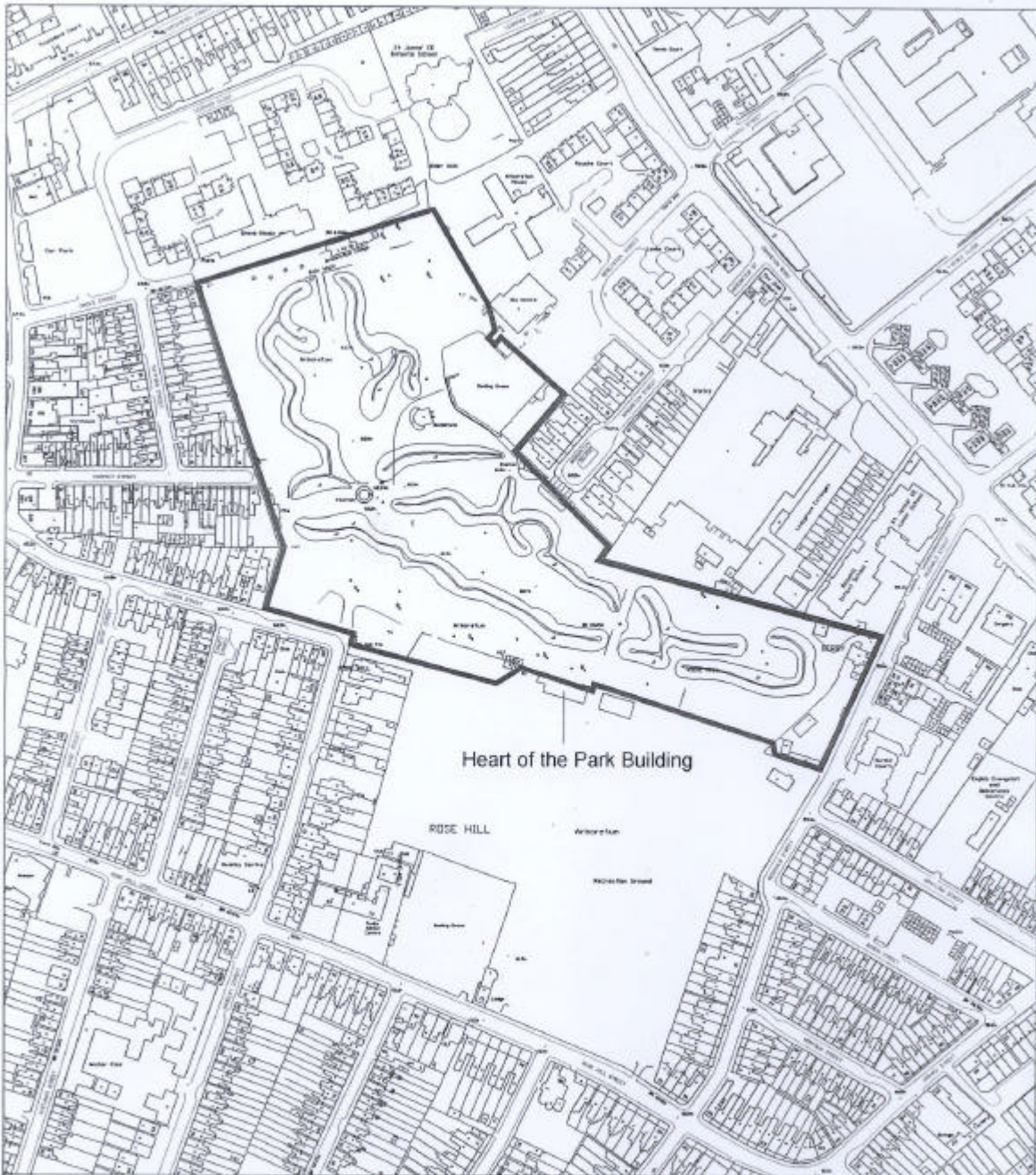
8. Any person offending against any of these byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
