4/05 Safer Neighbourhood Policing Boundaries

The Cabinet Member considered a report from the Community Regeneration Commission on Safer Neighbourhood Policing Boundaries.

The Commission recommended that the Cabinet Member support the proposed boundaries on the basis that:

- a) the proposed boundaries are not irreversible and that the Police are amenable to future boundary revisions
 - in light of experience and stakeholder views, and
 - with particular account being given to any future representations from the Council,
- b) the restructuring has the purpose of reducing crime and improving the community's perception of safety on the streets, and
- c) the Commission is provided with periodic updates, including the possible impacts on the policing of Derby consequential on the proposed merges of police forces

Decision

Resolved:

1. to adopt the recommendations of the Community Regeneration Commission as the Derby City Council response to the Derbyshire Police proposals
2. to provide the Commission with regular updates on how the boundaries are working.
