

Questions about the Environmental Statement

1. Paragraph 16.2.7 – are the figures quoted for 7 days per week or for 5 days per week?
 - a. What is the tolerance on those figures?
2. Paragraph 16.2.11 – The report quotes a predicted increase in traffic of 2.2%. Is this a 2.2% increase in total vehicles? If so, would it not be more useful to quote the increase in the number of heavy goods vehicles?
3. Paragraph 16.3.6 - What degree of certainty is there that emissions of NO₂ will be as quoted?
4. Paragraph 16.5.12 – Which herbicide will be used to kill the knotweed and how will it be guaranteed not to damage other surrounding vegetation?
5. The statement says that the waste treatment facility will have a negligible effect on air quality. How will this be quantified?
6. Paragraph 16.2.8 – The statement explains that the site is accessible by sustainable modes of transport. What incentives will there be for staff and visitors to use sustainable modes of transport?
7. How has it been ascertained that traffic increase will not have any perceptible environment effect?
8. Creating a junction on Sinfin Lane may increase incidents of Personal Injury Accidents (PIA)? What are you going to do about it?
9. When new housing is built (Stenson Fields) this will further increase traffic and pollution. Has this been taken into account in the plans for the plants own emissions and traffic impact?
10. Can anybody give a guarantee that this plant will not worsen the health of local people and it will not bring on early deaths?
