

Urgent items due to be considered by Council Cabinet

Every month, the Council publishes a Forward Plan to indicate the key decisions that the Council Cabinet is likely to take in the months ahead.

The following decisions need to be taken urgently in order that they can be implemented as quickly as possible. For this reason Council Cabinet is likely to consider them at its next meeting on 14 August 2013. They were not included on the Forward Plan.

The items are detailed below

Item	Description
Osmaston Vision: Elton Road Quadrant Community Led Housing Development	The report is a response to a decision made by the Osmaston Community Association of Residents (OSCAR) Board on 24 July 2013. The Board voted to adopt the approach as outlined in the report as a temporary solution to enable the construction of the affordable homes at Elton Road Quadrant to be commenced in compliance with the Homes and Communities Agency timescales and thus avoid a potential withdrawal of funding.
Contract Housing Related Support	The report seeks approval to award the contract for the provision of housing-related support services from 1 October 2013. A decision is sought at the Council Cabinet meeting on 14 August 2013 to facilitate that. The item is due to be considered as a late item at the Adults and Health Overview and Scrutiny Board on 12 August 2013 in order that the board's views can be considered by Council Cabinet alongside the report.
