



Urgent items due to be considered by Council Cabinet

Every month, the Council publishes a Forward Plan to indicate the key decisions that the Council Cabinet is likely to take in the months ahead.

The following decisions need to be taken urgently in order that they can be implemented as quickly as possible. For this reason Council Cabinet is likely to consider them at its next meeting on 11 September 2013. They were not included on the Forward Plan.

The items are detailed below

Item	Description
Derby's Innovation Campus	This is a complex, predominantly externally funded project, with tight but changeable timescales. It requires urgent consideration by Council Cabinet in order to remain on schedule and to ensure the external funding is used appropriately.
Roman House: Refurbishment for Relocation of Children and Young People's Services	The recent marketing of Roman House to find a developer partner was unsuccessful, but has enabled us to reappraise the property as part of our asset management review, from which Officers are recommending its re-use for specialist Council services. We need to move quickly if this opportunity is to be realised.
