Safer Driver Campaign A Safer Driver Campaign will delivered via relevant agencies, e.g. DCC, Highways Agency. The 17 – 25 years age group who are at greatest risk of being involved in a road traffic accident will be targeted. Particular danger periods will be identified and targeted, e.g. the period immediately after the clocks are changed and lighting conditions are altered when road traffic accidents are statistically more likely to occur. Accident hotspots will be targeted.	£4,000
Schools Parking Campaign The project will aim to recruit the pupils at local schools to promote key messages about road safety and parking in and around schools. The project will be managed by a steering group that included representatives from all local schools, the Police Safer Neighbourhood Team, DCC Road Safety and the Neighbourhood Board, supported by the Neighbourhood Manager and Emma Falivena (Extended School Co-ordinator).	£1,500

<p>SKIP DAY</p> <p>The proposal is to provide a clean up campaign involving providing 25 – 30 large skips in strategic locations throughout the ward.
