



**Derby City Adults Commissioning Board
Terms of Reference (Draft)**

Purpose

The Adults Care Board will lead the integrated commissioning of strategic health, housing and social care priorities for adults in Derby, as determined by the city's Health and Wellbeing Board.

Key Duties

1. To establish and implement agreed health, housing and social care priorities for the well-being of adults in Derby.
2. To drive system change and redesign, where necessary, in order to improve health and wellbeing outcomes for people of the City
3. To agree the key joint commissioning priorities to deliver the agreed Health & Wellbeing strategy outcomes
4. To align the wider commissioning decisions for health and wellbeing in the City
5. To support the delivery of key joint health, housing and social care outcomes identified in national strategies effectively and efficiently
6. To support the development of information-sharing to create a robust dataset that drives integrated commissioning decisions in health, housing and social care
7. To support the development of a skilled and sustainable workforce to commission and deliver health, housing and social care for adults in Derby
8. To oversee any local health and social care pooled budgets agreed and other jointly funded schemes.
9. To monitor key performance indicators relating to integrated commissioning priority areas
10. To advise the Health and Wellbeing Board on policy and implementation issues.
