**3. Reasons for proposing to consider the matter in private session**

The report will be considered in public, however there will be Appendices to the report which will include information which is commercially sensitive and which could prejudice the council's negotiating position if the information provided is made public. The Scrutiny Chair has therefore agreed to exempt this information under paragraph 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972. Furthermore, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.

**4. Reason for notice not being given of this intention 28 days prior to the meeting taking place**

The information in the appendices was requested by the Executive Scrutiny Board at its meeting on 12 June 2018 and therefore it was not possible to give 28 days notice prior to the meeting taking place. The report was due to be considered by Council Cabinet at its meeting on 13 June 2018 and could not wait until the next scheduled meeting.

It was recommended to Councillor Alan Graves, Chair of the Executive Scrutiny Board, that this matter be considered in private session. This was agreed by Councillor Graves on 13 June 2018.
