RECOMMENDATION

1. For Members to give their views on the Climate Change Board strategy

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 During the 2008-09 municipal year the Climate Change Commission undertook a topic review focussing on what the Council and its partners were doing to reduce their carbon emissions. A report was made to Cabinet in February 2009, and this was referred to the Climate Change Board for response.
- 2.2 The Climate Change Board also received a series of recommendations from the Energy Saving Trust on how to take forward the work of the Climate Change and Energy Management Unit. It was agreed that the responses to both of these sets of recommendations should be combined into a Climate Change Board strategy and action programme.
- 2.3 At their meeting on 31 March 2009 the Commission agreed that the strategy would come to a future meeting for consultation. The draft strategy is attached at appendix two. The consultation will take the form of a workshop for Members to go through the strategy document.
