#### 3. Reasons for proposing to consider the matter in private session

The report includes staffing implications and information which is commercially sensitive and which may potentially prejudice the council's negotiating position and is therefore exempt under paragraphs 1 and 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972. Furthermore, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.

## 4. Reason for notice not being given of this intention 28 days prior to the meeting taking place

It was originally anticipated that the report would not contain the commercially sensitive information and when this became known, the deadline for giving notice had already passed.

It was recommended to Councillor Paul Pegg, Chair of the Planning Housing and Leisure Overview and Scrutiny Board, that this matter be considered in private session. This was agreed by Councillor Pegg on 22 October 2013.
