10/03 Minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on 28 November 2002 were approved as a correct record.

11/03 Local Determination

The Committee considered a report from the Director of Corporate Services and Monitoring Officer, setting a proposed procedure for dealing with investigation reports completed by ethical standards officers and referred to the monitoring officer.

Under the Local Authorities (Code of Conduct) (Local Determination) Regulations 2003, Monitoring Officers had to arrange for their Standards Committees to determine whether or not a member had failed to follow the Code of Conduct and if so, what, if any, penalties should be applied following a referral. Attached to the report was a proposed procedure for dealing with reports referred.

The procedure generally followed the guidance issued by the Standards Board for England. However the Board had recommended that panels should be established of three or five members to make determinations. The Committee were of the view that as it was made up of six members, it would prefer to continue to meet as a full Committee and not exclude one of its members from a hearing.

Resolved

- 1 To approve the procedure for dealing with investigation reports completed by ethical standards officers and referred to the monitoring officer.
- To ask the Director of Corporate Services and Monitoring Officer to send a copy of the procedure, and supporting flow chart, to the Standards Board for England, pointing out the reasons for not complying with the guidance in respect of the number of members on the Panel.
- To note the need to have an alternative procedures for cases that had been referred from the Standards Board for England but had not involved an ethical standards officer.

12/03 Ethical Framework Training

The Committee considered a report from the Director of Corporate Services and Monitoring Officer, setting out the draft programme for the Ethical Framework Training for Councillors to be held on 7 January 2004.

The Committee suggested minor changes to the timetable.

Resolved to approve the programme for the Ethical Framework Training for Councillors to be held on 7 January 2004 subject to the minor changes suggested at the meeting.
