Summary – From October 2018, all local authorities will be working towards the new Well Managed Highway Infrastructure Code of Practice - Oct 16. Our approach to this new guidance is set out in our adopted Asset Management Policy, Strategy and Framework. The Framework includes 27 documents, some of which require endorsement through our executive processes. The four documents being presented at Cabinet have been developed and finalised during autumn 2018 and require cabinet approval. There is a high likelihood that some or all will be required for inclusion in the Councils defence against a third party claim on the highway.
