## 13/08 Amendments to Delegation of Powers

The Committee considered a report from the Director of Environmental Services on Amendments to Delegation of Powers. There are large numbers of new applications and cases concerning existing licences for hackney carriage and private hire vehicles and drivers currently being presented to Committee. The Group Leader of Taxi Licensing had to schedule a whole day of interviews every three weeks, which subsequently lead to a hearing of the Taxi Licensing Appeals Sub-Committee every three weeks. The proposals represent a means of better utilising available resources more productively.

# 14/08 Multi-agency Taxi Licensing Enforcement at East Midlands Airport

The Committee considered a report on Multi-agency Taxi Licensing Enforcement at East Midlands Airport. Taxi Enforcement Officers took part in two multi-agency enforcement exercises at East Midlands Airport, one in June and another in September 2008. The exercises were organised by North West Leicestershire District Council and were attended by Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire and Leicestershire Local Authorities, Leicestershire Police, Leicestershire Road Policing Unit (RPU), Vehicle Operator Service Agency (VOSA), Department of Work and Pensions (DWP) and H M Revenue and Customs.

## 15/08 Statistics for Taxi Licensing & Enforcement Activities – Quarters 1 & 2 2008

The Committee considered a report on Statistics for Taxi Licensing & Enforcement Activities – Quarters 1 & 2 2008. It was noted that an increase in private hire vehicle and drivers' licenses issued has been observed in the first six months compared to the same period last year. This may be in part due to the contract exemption removal, which meant previously unlicensed chauffeur vehicles and drivers required licensing.
