Summary – The Clean Bus Technology Fund is a £30m two-year grant fund for retrofitting buses with technology to reduce tailpipe emissions and is now open for local authorities in England and Wales to apply for. The primary aim of the fund is to help local authorities to reduce roadside concentrations of nitrogen dioxide (NO2) in the shortest possible time particularly in those areas exceeding statutory limit values. It is a two-year fund, with £15m available in each year. Local authorities can apply for up to £1.5m in each year with a maximum of £3m across the two. All applications must be received by the deadline of 17 November 2017.
