SUSPENSION NOTICES

Since 25 April 2012, the Authority has been able to serve a suspension notice on those who hold a licence under the Licensing Act 2003, who have not paid their annual fees.

37 suspension notices were issued during the period. The total outstanding was £6920. 33 paid realising £6420. Of the remaining 4, 2 licences were found to have lapsed due to companies going into liquidation and 2 have been surrendered.
