Consultation Findings: Consultation Questions

- Respondents were asked to prioritise statements regarding the future design and delivery of community services
- Top ranked :
 - Future service contracts should be made available to any GP or pharmacy in Derby who meets minimum service delivery standards with payment being made on a standard unit rate.
 - Unit costs should (if possible) remain largely unchanged but with payment being made against specific audiences of greatest need as identified by Derby City Council with new pathways developed for non-target audiences.
 - Delivery of interventions should be condensed within up to 9 priority geographical locations in Derby which offer the full range of Public Health contracted services.
