The Apprenticeship Project update

Purpose

- 1.1 To provide an update on the Council's Levy payments and drawdown to 31 May 2019.
- 1.2 To provide a breakdown of the number of current apprenticeship programmes that shows how many new start Apprentices and existing colleagues are currently on programme.

Supporting information

4.1 Levy Payments

As of 31 May 2019 the Council has transferred a total of £1,657,475 into the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) Apprenticeship Levy Digital Account and has drawn down £266,400 for apprenticeship training programmes.

This equates to spending 15.95% of our Levy fund which is actually above the national average spend of 14%.

4.2 Breakdown of the Apprenticeship Numbers

From April 18 to date we have 38 new start Apprentices and 86 existing colleagues currently on programmes.

Therefore the total number of colleagues on programme is 124.

New starts are on level 2 and 3 programmes.

Existing colleagues range from level 3 to level 7 programmes.

Please refer to appendix 2 for a breakdown of the programmes currently being studied in the three Directorates.

The reason the total is different to the number identified on roll in appendix 1 is that not all of the current apprentices are showing on the Apprenticeship Levy Digital Account System due to an update lag.

4.3 Apprenticeship Project Group

Key work streams the Project Group are currently focusing on:

- Aiming to implement a new recruitment campaign three times a year September, January and April, to support increasing new starts.
- Working with Derby University to start managers on the Level 3 Team Lead / Supervisor programme potentially in September 2019.
- Next Leadership and Management level 5 and 6 programmes cohort starting in September 2019.
- Working with the Adults and Childrens Social Care Teams to support them with their training needs – from Level 2 Social Care programmes through to the Social Worker degree apprenticeship.
- 25% transfer please refer to 4.5.
- Supporting the lead officer with his Work Experience Strategy for Children in Care Project.
- Ensuring continued compliance with the ESFA and procurement regulations.
- Continuing to develop robust quality assurance processes and monitoring procedures.
- Reviewing our Apprenticeship training provision.

4.4 Apprenticeship Strategy

The draft Apprenticeship Strategy has been developed, involving key stakeholders within the Council. The draft has been shared with the Apprenticeship Board and is scheduled to be discussed in more detail at the next meeting of the Board on 3 July 2019.

4.5 **25% Levy Transfer**

Employers who pay the apprenticeship Levy and have unused apprenticeship funds can transfer up to 25% of their annual Levy to other employers should they choose to.

The Council can therefore transfer up to approximately £195,000 this financial year.

To optimise the use of 25% Levy transfer options that are currently being explored include:

- A briefing note was tabled at the People Directorate Management Team in April 2019 with recommendations for the DMT to consider a range of broad options and policy issues to enable them to recommend a preferred approach to the Apprenticeship Board about how some/all of the 25% Levy transfer for 2019/20 could be invested with local partners.
- 2. The possibility of transferring some of our Levy fund to Derby Homes.
- 3. The possibility of transferring some of our Levy fund to schools that are not Council maintained.

The Apprenticeship Board is being asked to give a view on the options.

Public/stakeholder engagement

5.1 Council departments and external training providers.

Other options

6.1 Do nothing. This is not considered to be a viable option, as the Council wants to maximise the Levy spend and the Government has set a mandatory Public Sector target of 2.3%.

Financial and value for money issues

7.1 The Council continues to make contributions to the Levy on a monthly basis. Some of the funding is being used to pay for apprentice programmes every month.

Legal implications

8.1 We are working with Legal and Procurement to ensure we are meeting our legal obligations with the Levy and procurement rules.
