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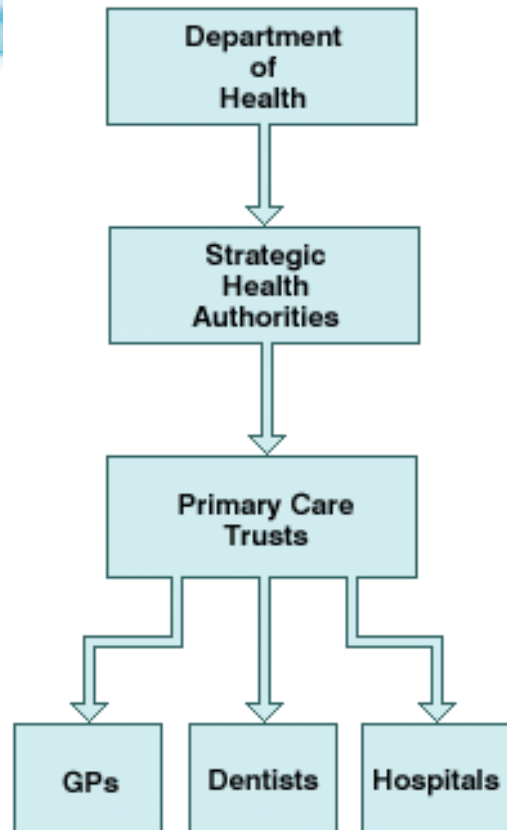

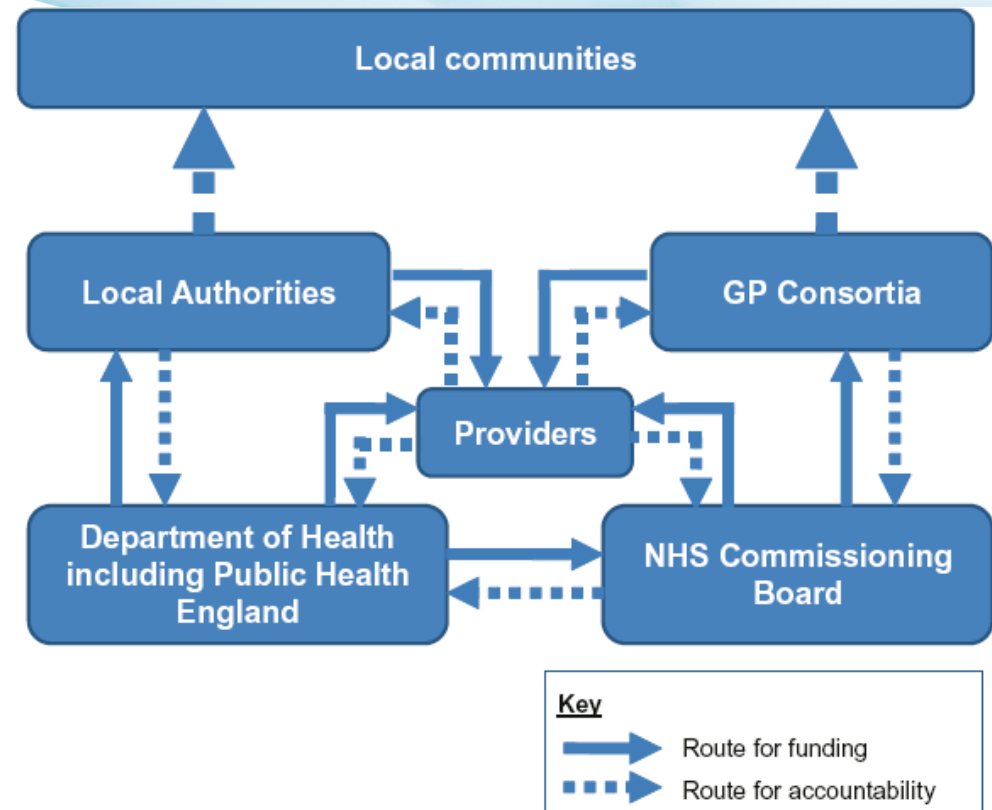

Healthy Lives, Healthy People Summary

- Ring-fenced public health budget – currently estimated at £4 billion.
- Proposed shift towards localism – with devolvment of responsibilities and funding.
- Transfer of health improvement functions to local government
- Creation of Public Health England

Healthy Lives, Healthy People Summary

- Shared / partnership responsibility for delivery of public health
- Focus on coherent approach across different stages of life
- Replacement of 'top-down targets' with the development of a public health outcomes framework and associated incentive scheme.
- Promotion of an evidence-based approach to public health

- Public Health Responsibility Deal
- Public Health Outcomes Framework

- sexual health and teenage pregnancy; and
- pandemic flu.

Autumn 2011

- health protection, emergency preparedness and response.



What is Public Health?

Three domains:

- health improvement
(including people's lifestyles as well as inequalities in health and the wider social influences of health)
- health protection
(including infectious diseases, environmental hazards and emergency preparedness)
- health services quality
(including service planning, efficiency, audit and evaluation).

Changes to Public Health model

3 domains of public health:

- health improvement – *moves from NHS (PCT) to Local Authority*
- health protection – *moves from NHS (PCT) to Public Health England & Directors of Public Health / Local Authorities jointly*
- health services – *little clarity at this point.*

However GP Commissioners and LAs have “equal and explicit obligation” to prepare JSNA. Also Health and Wellbeing Boards prepare a Joint Health and Wellbeing strategy outlining how all commissioners can work together...



Health and Wellbeing Board

- *Assess the needs of the population – Joint Strategic Needs Assessment*
- *Deliver the outcomes in the framework*
- *Promote integration and partnership through commissioning and pooled budgets*
- *Manage, evaluate and challenge performance*
