When the buildings were launched the various project boards were amalgamated into one. However this project board was for updating on operational progress only. Connect Derby is well established and is now at a stage where more Strategic guidance and direction is required from key service heads and the Strategic Board will provide this. The charging policy is being introduced as the managed workspace sector has become very competitive in the past few years with seven other providers now on the market offering similar services. Connect Derby requires the flexibility to negotiate rents with new and existing customers to remain competitive within this sector. This will encourage maintaining and increasing occupancy and rent levels.
