## **Moorways Sports Village update**

### **Purpose**

- 1.1 To update the Regeneration and Housing Scrutiny Review Board of the latest position with the Moorways Sports Village project.

### **Supporting information**

- 4.1 The project is being delivered within the approved Capital Budget of £42m.
- 4.2 The facility mix includes a ten lane 50m pool, water park, learner pool, health and fitness facilities, a café, soft play and other ancillary rooms.
- 4.3 Bowmer & Kirkland are the construction contractor and the build commenced in January 2020.
- 4.4 Work is currently being completed on both the substructure and superstructure of the facility.
- 4.5 Moorways Sports Village is due to open in Spring 2022.

## **Public/stakeholder engagement**

- 5.1 The project has a communications plan which co-ordinates public engagement.
- 5.2 Bowmer and Kirkland provide regular newsletters for local residents updating them with progress.
- 5.3 Regular dialogue is held with aquatic clubs to ensure user requirements are fulfilled.
