The policy needs to apply to the whole of Derby with an assessment framework in place to justify and be open/transparent about the decisions made. This assessment framework should consider a number areas: - Public safety - Prevention of Crime and Disorder - Prevention of Nuisance - Suitability of Applicant - Types of goods being sold and the location of other businesses including other street traders - Suitability of trading unit - Power - Advertising -Barriers - Hours of Trading - Cumulative impact - Selling the right goods - Hygiene standards/FHRS rating if a food business - Site Assessment Applying the policy to all the streets in Derby would make the policy fair and equitable but would also generate income and the Council would have control about where and when someone trades. Under the current proposals Ice Cream Vans would be exempt and what would in place to stop them rocking up outside schools at the end of the day? Under this draft policy people trading from private car parks or parks would be exempt. Yet the definition of a 'Street' includes 'any road, footway, beach or other areas to which the public have access without payment and so could include these areas for trading.



No comments

As a lot of traders in the City and in Parks don't trade all year round would it be a good idea to also offer an occasional street trading license which would allow businesses to trade in a particular pitch for up to so many days/year (30 perhaps). This would perhaps then allow for more variety of trading at these pitches over the course of a year which would be better for the citizens of Derby and hopefully the economy. The policy needs to include more on preventing a nuisance and in particular what businesses need to do with waste generated from their business (rubbish, oil and water) and any littering that might occur as a result of them trading. Section 3.8 Suitability of Trading Unit – The Food and Safety Team at Derby City does not have the resources to ensure that all mobiles are inspected prior to trading and some mobile's might be registered with other LA's and are not necessarily Derby City's to inspect. For section 3.8 and 5.1 - need to check on the FHRS website to ensure that the business has been inspected or is 'Awaiting Inspection' - this means that they will at least be registered with a LA. The policy should include something about food businesses either being classed as 'Awaiting Inspection' or a minimum of 3 to trade and what happens if a rating of 2 or below is awarded. In Section 4 businesses should also have to submit: - An up to date LPG Gas Safety Certificate for LPG gas fixtures and systems (if appropriate) - A Fire Safety RA In Section 5 – we should consider the need to consult with the Fire Authority? The policy needs a very clear and transparent application process including how decisions are made and the grounds/process for refusal. The policy also needs detailed information on our Enforcement Actions and perhaps details on a staged approach to enforcement should there be breaches of conditions, any nuisance issues, complaints etc. The policy should include what happens to a food business if their rating drop to a 2 or below. Check with legal that it is right regarding the no right to appeal.
