

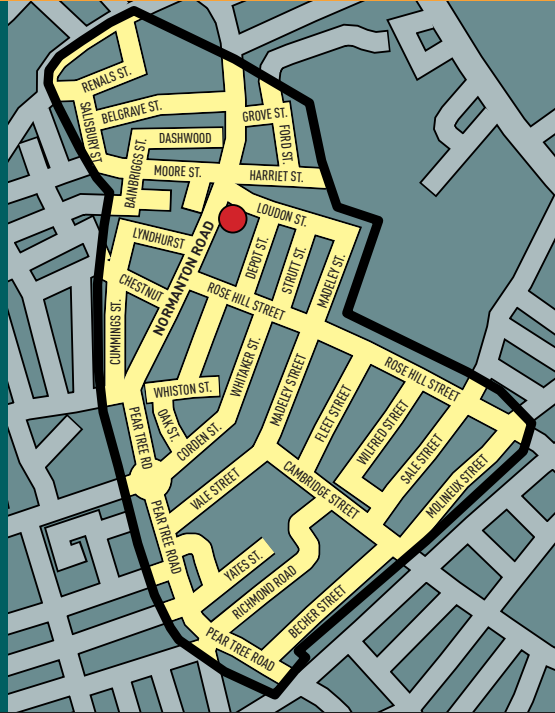
The Normanton Road Consultation Area

- Give side streets a private appearance
- Provide dedicated bicycle parking stands

Normanton Road is a successful and thriving District Centre which serves the wider neighbourhood with a range of facilities and shops.

The road is very busy throughout the day and there is only a limited amount of parking space available. Some of the adjoining residential streets are also used by shoppers and traders for parking which adds to the general level of congestion.

The City Council has a vision of making the area a pleasant and desirable place to live and work, and would like local residents and businesses to help them achieve this. In the first instance, we would like to give everyone the opportunity to express their views on the parking and traffic situation and at the same time make any other comments regarding the area.

These comments will then be taken into consideration when deciding on what type of improvements are needed for Normanton Road.

One possible approach is to install raised plateaux at the entrances to the side streets to make them feel more private, and to discourage traders and shoppers from parking there.

One idea is to continue raised pavements across the entrances to side roads to make walking down Normanton Road safer and easier for pedestrians.
