Summary – Connect Derby is the Council's managed workspace service. It was launched in 2014 and has been very successful in achieving its objectives. The individual managed workspaces initially had their own project board's setup to report progress and support decision making. When the buildings were launched the various project boards were amalgamated into one. However this project board was for updating on operational progress only. Connect Derby is well established and is now at a stage where more Strategic guidance and direction is required from key service heads and the Strategic Board will provide this. The charging policy is being introduced as the managed workspace sector has become very competitive in the past few years with seven other providers now on the market offering similar services. Connect Derby requires the flexibility to negotiate rents with new and existing customers to remain competitive within this sector. This will encourage maintaining and increasing occupancy and rent levels.

Summary – The Department for Transport's 2014 Transport Resilience Review recommended that local highway authorities should "identify a 'resilient network' to which they will give priority, in order to maintain economic activity and access to key services during extreme weather". This has been reinforced with the release of the Well-Managed Highway Infrastructure Code of Practice: October 2016 as one of 36 recommendations. The Resilient Network will be the bare minimum a highway authority will need to maintain when unforeseen events or extreme weather reduce the capacity of the authority's resources.

Summary – Skid resistance is an important property relating to the safety of highway users, particularly in wet or damp conditions. Over the course of a road's life, the surface can lose some of its characteristic associated with grip. Effective maintenance of the highway network includes the systematic monitoring of skid resistance of the road surface and to take a proactive approach to maintaining the network to an appropriate standard. The policy provides our defence against third party claims and the possibility of a Corporate Manslaughter case.
